FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code §2-353.01 and §2-353.02, 27 DCMR Section 2200.4

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The District of Columbia Government (District) Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP), on behalf of the Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO), have a continuous need for Tecknomic, Inc. to provide temporary resources to perform helpdesk, administrative and field support duties.

The term of the contract shall be from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

3. ESTIMATED FAIR AND REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated fair and reasonable price is \$1,155,360.00.

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY:

The Contracting Officer has determined that the Contractor:

- a. TECKNOMIC, INC. has adequate financial resources to perform the contract or the ability to obtain those resources. Tecknomic, Inc. maintains clear history, secured financing, and a low Supplier Evaluation Risk (SER) rating, based on Dun and Bradstreet report dated September 19, 2018;
- b. TECKNOMIC, INC. is able to comply with the required or proposed delivery or performance schedule, based upon the bidder's or offeror's existing commercial and government contract commitments;

- c. TECKNOMIC, INC. has a satisfactory performance record and has been in business for more than 15 years;
- d. TECKNOMIC, INC. has a satisfactory record of integrity and business ethics, based upon DC Excluded Parties List dated September 10, 2018, and System of Award Management report dated September 19, 2018;
- e. TECKNOMIC, INC. has a satisfactory record of compliance with the law, including labor and civil rights laws and rules and part A of subchapter X of Chapter 2 of this title [§ 2-219.01 *et seq.*];
- f. TECKNOMIC, INC. has the ability to obtain, the necessary organization, experience, accounting, operational control, and technical skills;
- g. TECKNOMIC, INC. has the ability to obtain, the necessary production, construction, technical equipment, and facilities;
- h. TECKNOMIC, INC. has not exhibited a pattern of overcharging the District;
- i. TECKNOMIC, INC. does not have an outstanding debt with the District or the federal government in a delinquent status of more than the greater of \$1,000 or 1% of the contract value, up to \$25,000. TECKNOMIC, INC. is compliant with Clean Hands dated August 27, 2018; and
- j. TECKNOMIC, INC. is otherwise qualified and is eligible to receive an award under applicable laws and rules.
