FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code § 2-354.04 and 27 DCMR 1700.1

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Government of the District of Columbia, Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (DYRS), requires the Contractor to install and maintain the existing Justice Case Management System, FAMCare.

3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE: \$178,667.11 based on quote received.

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

Based on market research conducted by the Contract Administrator, FAMCare is proprietary software wholly owned by Global Vision Technologies (GVT). This includes all software and coding contained within the application.

FAMCare was purchased in January of 2014 and went into production on Sept 11, 2014. Considerable development work has been done solely by GVT's developers in the creation of database imports, forms development, imbedded process flows and reporting mechanisms. Additionally, more work needs to be done to complete the database imports from the legacy system YES as well as the continuance of the development of forms, database queries and reporting to meet agency needs.

Any break in service will have a serious detrimental effect on the successful and complete transition from the legacy system and will disrupt critical operations in case management.
