FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code § 2-354.04, 27 DCMR 1304 and 1702

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The District of Columbia, Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA) has a minimum need for a contractor to provide Intensive In-House Family Preservation/Reunification mental health services. The proposed term for the contract is from October 1, 2011 through March 31, 2012.

3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:

\$401,280.00

4. FACTORS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

CFSA is in the process of soliciting bids for these services at the present time. In the interim, it is imperative to have these contractors to continue to provide needed mental health services. Failure to allow the proposed contractors to continue mental health services for the stated period of time would seriously jeopardize the continuation of necessary governmental functions and may jeopardize the health, safety and welfare of the District's children and youth.

Therefore it is in the best interest of the District to award these contracts, so as to prevent any disruption of services for CFSA children and youth and allow ample time to solicit for mental health services.
