FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

27 DCMR 1702, Section 1702.5; D.C. Official Code Section 2-303.05(a)(1)

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Contractor shall provide respite care services for a client on a as needed basis.

3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE COSTS:

\$32,500.00

4. FACT WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT

The District of Columbia Child and Family Services Agency (“CFSA”) intends to enter into a contract with the Hospital for Sick Children (HSC) to provide respite care placement services for a medically fragile wards of CFSA on an as needed basis.

Therefore, it is in the best interest of the District to procure, via sole source, the proposed services from the Hospital for Sick Children. The Child and Family Services Agency proposes awarding a sole source contract to the above-referenced vendor.

The Hospital for Sick Children – Pediatric Center has a well-known success rate in providing respite care services under the medical programs at HSC, based primarily on the 1 East and 2 East units that serve children with a wide range of medical conditions, including heart disease, chronic lung disease, feeding problems and complications of prematurity. Most medical patients come to the Hospital for Sick Children (HSC) from other hospitals, but no longer need intensive or acute care, and are working on a safe transition home. Finally, the provider has experience servicing the target population, which consists of children in the child welfare system.

Failure to do so would negatively impact the District’s ability to deliver critical government services.
