1. MINIMUM NEED:

The Government of the District of Columbia, Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the Department of Transportation, Urban Forestry Administration, is seeking service, repairs and supplies for Chippers and Stump Grinders for Emergency Operations.

2. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated fair and reasonable price is \$6,000.00

3. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

Vermeer Mid Atlantic in Annapolis Junction, Maryland is in full service dealership of Vermeer equipment for both arborist and underground construction contractors. They are the sole supplier of OEM Vermeer equipment, parts and accessories in the Baltimore/Washington region. Parts or Services from any vendor other than Vermeer during the warranty periods could void future warranty repairs on the unit. Vermeer Mid Atlantic, Inc. territory covers all of Maryland, Washington, D.C., and Delaware.

On April 13, 2012 a market survey was conducted Bandit Industries, Inc., Sears and Vermeer Mid Atlantic, Inc. was contacted, Vermeer Mid Atlantic was the only company who responded.
