

**DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS
FOR A
SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT**

AGENCY: Office of Unified Communications (OUC)

CAPTION: Intergraph CAD/Biz Talk Interoperability System Migration

FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code § 2-354.04, 27 DCMR 1304 and 1702

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME) has an ongoing need for a contractor to provide migration services of some of the existing I/CAD System interfaces to the new Intergraph Interoperability Framework / BizTalk solution. The period of performance shall not exceed September 30, 2012.

3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE: \$ 589,000.00

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SINGLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

- A. OUC requires special expertise to update and maintain their specialized system/equipment.
- B. The Contractor has exclusive and in-depth product support and product application knowledge for OUC's I/CAD System. The proposed contractor is familiar with the needs of OUC and has been a past provider of the system, these quality migration services, preventative maintenance and repair solutions.
- C. Additionally, the Contractor is the only vendor authorized to provide migration services on the existing I/CAD System, which will interface to the new Intergraph Interoperability Framework / BizTalk solution, as it is proprietary.
- D. The pricing offered by the vendor has been deemed fair and reasonable.
