FINDINGS

1. **AUTHORIZATION:**

D.C. Official Code § 2-354.04, 27 DCMR 1304 and 1702

2. **MINIMUM NEED:**

The Government of the District of Columbia, Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA), has an immediate need for the services of Dr. Allison M. Jackson to provide medical record review and analysis specific to an investigation on Medical Abuse allegations.

3. **ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:**

\$5,250.00

4. **FACTORS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:**

- (a) The proposed provider, Dr. Allison M. Jackson, provides medical record review and analysis. Dr. Allison M. Jackson has extensive experience presenting medical analysis through the Freddie Mac Foundation Child & Adolescent Protection Center.
- (b) Due to the time sensitive nature of the investigation, an experienced medical professional is required to help present the medical abuse analysis effectively.
- (c) The proposed provider is aware of the services to be provided, is capable of performing these services, and has performed in this capacity before.
- (d) A market survey was performed by attempting to identify medical professionals with extensive analytical experience involving medical abuse.
