**1. AUTHORIZATION**

D.C. Official Code §2-354.04, 27 DCMR 1304, 1700, 1701 and 2005.6(b)

**2. MINIMUM NEED:**

The Department of Public Works (DPW), Parking Enforcement Management Administration has a need for continued maintenance and support service for the EZTag Mobile enforcement system, hardware and software applications currently in use by DPW.

**3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:**

The total estimate reasonable price is \$600,000 - \$700,00 based on the current option year pricing.

**4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY EXTENSION OF THE CONTRACT:**

Contract DCTO-2011-C-0011 was awarded on March 1, 2011 on a sole source basis. The contract contained four, one-year options periods. The final option period was exercised effective October 1, 2014 through September 31, 2015.

The Parking Enforcement System is integral to DPW's operation; therefore DPW requires uninterrupted support service.

The services required are exempt from competition in accordance with section 413 (8) of the Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010. EZTag is the only vendor that can provide the continued licensing, maintenance and support of the system.
