FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code § 2-303.05(a)(1), 27 DCMR 1702.3

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The D.C. Fire and Emergency Medical Services (FEMS) needs a Phase I Swede Survival System Observation Container to provide “live” fire training for the burning of Class A materials.

3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:

The estimated reasonable cost of the contract is \$19,000.00.

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:


Draeger Safety Inc., Swede Survival Systems Division is the sole source manufacturer and distributor in the United States of the Phase 1, Observation Container “live fire” training systems using Class A burn materials. Draeger Safety Inc. also provides unique instructional programs designed for each phase of our systems meeting N.F.P.A. 1403, 1500, 1001, and the Swedish Rescue Services Agency Standards. The training curriculum shall be traceable to the training program developed and refined over the past twenty years by the Swedish Rescue Services College in Skovde, Sweden.

There are no comparable systems to the Swede Survival Systems and no comparable instructional programs in the United States. All of the systems must meet the design criteria of Draeger Safety Inc. Instructors who have been certified by Draeger Safety Inc. must conduct the instructional programs. Any deviation from the above will void these programs.

Given these findings, it is in the best interest of the District to procure Burn Containers from Draeger Safety, Inc.
