**1. MINIMUM NEED:**

The Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Management Administration has a need for rigid, plastic trash liners that will fit in the receptacles located throughout the District. The trash receptacles are manufactured by Victor Stanley, Inc.

**2. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:**

\$79,940.00

**3. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:**

Victor Stanley, Inc. is the manufacturer of the Victor Stanley SDDC-42 Trash Receptacles and PL-36 Trash Liners. The liners are made on molds designed by Victor Stanley, Inc. Victor Stanley, Inc. is the manufacturer and sole supplier of the PL-36 plastic trash liners.

In the past the District attempted to purchase other liners but they tended to fit imperfectly. The Victor Stanley liners are the only liners that meet the specifications.
