FINDINGS

1. AUTHORIZATION:

D.C. Official Code § 2-354.04, 27 DCMR 1304 and 1701.2

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Government of the District of Columbia, Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA), has the following minimum need:

- (a) The Government of the District of Columbia, Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA) has a need to provide gift cards to wards and families of Washington, DC.
- (b) CFSA has an urgent need for the gift cards in order to assist CFSA youth that have an emergency need for household or personal items.

3. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:

\$50,000 is the requested for the gift cards for CFSA clients.

4. FACTORS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

- (a) The vendor is one of the largest food chain grocery stores in the Washington, DC region. Their stores are located in the areas where CFSA clients reside and as such can be reached easily by private vehicles or public transportation. In addition to food, both locations have a pharmacy that provides medications which may be needed at times. There are currently 20 Safeway stores located throughout Washington, DC. As opposed to 9 Giant stores. See attached printout from a Google search.
