1. MINIMUM NEED:

The Government of the District of Columbia, Department of Behavioral Health (DBH) Saint Elizabeths Hospital (SEH) requires the services of a Specialty Contractor to provide a Quality Assurance Manager to coordinate the delivery of services for the Hospitals Physical Security System at SEH. This Contractor shall be responsible for the planning, coordinating and delivery of services that would include technical assistance, software support and engineer support along with small project coordination. The Contractor shall also provide a physical security technician certified, trained and experienced with the system and physical security camera equipment for response onsite and via telecom.

2. FAIR AND REASONABLE PRICE:

The Specialty Contractor on-site provided a fair and reasonable price to perform the work affording time and costs savings to DBH. Based on industry standards and pricing, we communicated with manufacturers of similar devices and based on the estimated labor and materials, as well as, working in finished spaces and the necessary protection of work already in place. As such, we have determined the pricing is fair and reasonable at \$50,000.00.
