FINDINGS

1. AUTHORITY:

D.C. Official Code § 2-303.05 (a) (1), DCMR Title 27, Chapter 17 Section 1702.3 (b).

2. MINIMUM NEED:

The Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP) on behalf of the District Department of the Environment (DDOE) has a need for water quality dataloggers; to provide real time (water quality) monitoring information and mechanisms for reporting to the public. The dataloggers will monitor water quality in the Potomac River, a tributary of the Chesapeake Bay.

3. ESTIMATED FAIR AND REASONABLE COST:

The estimated reasonable cost for this contract is \$ 34,755.00

4. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY THE SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:

YSI, Inc. is the only manufacturer of the 6 Series Multi-Parameter Sondes (600, 6820, 6920, 6600) their compatible Sensors, and the EXO2 Sonde. No other manufacturer in the world makes these instruments. Also, no other manufacturer makes an instrument that is compatible with YSI sensors / probes. YSI only sells the 6 Series Multi-Parameter Sondes, their compatible Sensors, and the EXO2 Sonde directly.

A market survey was not done because the District is a partner to the Chesapeake Bay Agreement. Others partners of the Bay agreement, Maryland and Virginia have implemented real time monitoring using the specially equipped YSI monitoring units.
