

**DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS  
FOR A  
SINGLE AVAILABLE PROCUREMENT**

**1. MINIMUM NEED:**

The Department of Health (DOH) is seeking the continued services of a contractor to provide nurses and healthcare professionals to provide medical services to District residents and eligible persons under DOH's care. Services include medical screenings, full compliment of diagnostic and assessment services and treatment for minor and acute illness and injuries, as well as emergency and chronic care.

The period of performance for the sole source extension will be May 10, 2012 through September 30, 2012.

**2. ESTIMATED REASONABLE PRICE:**

The estimated fair and reasonable price to provide the required services for the period May 10, 2012 through September 30, 2012 are based on services rates under Option Year 4 of the current Human Care Agreement. The rates have been determined fair and reasonable based on current rates paid by the District.

**3. FACTS WHICH JUSTIFY SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT:**

Magnificus Corporation has been providing Nursing and Healthcare Professional Services for almost 5 years. DCHC-2007-H-0036 was competitively awarded on May 10, 2007 to Magnificus Corporation who responded to the Human Care Agreement Solicitation and was deemed qualified to provide all of the requirements. The Human Care was awarded for a base period of one year and contained four one-year option periods.

A Human Care Agreement Solicitation for a new Nurses and Healthcare Professional Services contract is currently being development however, the District will be unable to complete the procurement process until September 30, 2012.

In order to prevent a service disruption the District has a need to extend its present Human Care Agreement with Magnificus Corporation to September 30, 2012 to allow for the

completion of the competitive procurement process to procure a new Nursing and Healthcare Professional Services' Provider. Under this extension, Magnificus will continue to provide services as presently outlined in the Human Care Agreement DCHC-2007-H-0036.

In consideration of the District's minimum need and the fact that a competitive solicitation is under way a market survey was not conducted.
