

	<b>Question</b>	<b>Response</b>
1	Is voice and data work done by a different agency? If not is there enough space in the patch panels to handle the additional circuits that will be needed?	Voice and Data are out of the scope. The General Contractor is to provide necessary flexes so that OCTO can install the necessary system.
2	Is ADT providing the equipment? If so, can we get a list of equipment furnished by them. Are we to include the cost of this equipment in our bids or will there be an allowance for this item?	Prospective bidders should get all information and quotes on ADT items and include them in their pricing.  ADT Contact Person is Mr. Tom Mahoney. He can be reached at 571-338-4480
3	Is the fire alarm interface work done by a different agency? If not where does our work terminate in order that no warranty of your existing system is compromised?	The General Contractor will take the Fire Alarm System up to the panel. From that point, our existing contractor (Haislip) will do the connection to the existing building system.  Prospective bidders are encouraged to contact Haislip for information pertaining to the fire alarm system. The Haislip contact person is James Haislip. He can be reached at 703-449-9500.
4	What are the hours of work for this project? Does work have to be scheduled during evening and weekends or will we have access during normal business hours to do the construction work?	This work will be performed after 6:00 p.m. on weekdays, weekends and holidays. Prospective bidders are encouraged to consider this fact in their pricing.
5	As a CBE/SBE am I required to hire CBE subs?	Contractors are required to subcontract 35% to a Small Business Enterprise (SBE) in accordance with Section M.1.6. of the Invitation for Bid.

6	Can I hire non-CBE subs?	Yes, as long as it doesn't conflict with the 35% requirement stated above.
7	As a CBE am I required to have 35% CBE participation?	See response to Question No. 5.
8	Is the CBE requirement RFP specific (ie does it change with each order)?	This is not an RFP. The District intends to award a firm fixed priced contract in accordance with Section B of the Invitation for Bid.
