# ATTACHMENT A

## UDC BUILDING 52

### DCAM-2009-B-0040 Questions and Answers

- (1). **Q:** On drawing T108, detail 1 this is a PA Riser: Thus Riser shows 51 speakers where as the floor plan shows 36. Please indicate which is correct.
- A:** Contractor to refer to the floor plans for the locations of all of the speakers. Contractor to confirm quantities as ASE counted 52 speakers on the floor plans.
- (2). **Q:** General Note 1 states: Provide the Following: (blank). Please provide missing information.
- A:** Disregard General Note 1.
- (3). **Q:** What type of wiring is used for this?
- A:** Plenum rated shielded twisted pair wiring is used for the speakers.
- (4). **Q:** In Women's Room 005B there is Lighting Fixture Type "T2", but this Fixture is not listed on Lighting Fixtures Schedule on E-001. Please advise.
- A:** T1 and T2 are perimeter, parabolic louver light fixtures with 6' and 4' length with 8 1/4" aperture. T1 and T2 manufactured by Lightholier #PTS7-LENGTH-EB2.
- (5). **Q:** In Counseling and Advertisement Study area (at Doors 037B & 037D) there are Exit Signs Type "E", but these Fixtures are not listed on Schedule. Please advise.
- A:** The light fixture with the exit light symbol in light fixture schedule with no arrow/chevron is type E.
- (6). **Q:** There are Occupancy Sensors, but Catalog Number is not listed in Section 16145 (Lighting Control Devices). Also, Catalog Number for Power Pack is not listed in this section. Please Advise.
- A:** As specified in symbol list, please provide dual technology, ceiling Mount in room. The occupancy sensor shall be WattStopper #DT-300 or equal. In corridor, please provide ultrasonic technology. The

occupancy sensor shall be WattStopper #W-200H or equal. The power pack shall be B series with appropriate voltage.

- (7). **Q:** While inventories of materials/equipment onsite have been provided in the contract documents, there is no indication of work that was completed to date, on the drawings. This makes the pricing difficult all but the previous GC. In order to “level” out the playing field and in order for DC to receive truly competitive proposals, can the COR provide a percentage complete to the following work in place by trade? Such as;

Plumbing- it appears that risers are in place on numerous floors for new restrooms.

HVAC piping- it appears that copper piping is in place for the VAV Units.

Demolition- it appears that a good percentage of the demolition has been completed.

Electrical- it appears that some work has been performed.

**A:** ALL DEMO/NEW WORK IDENTIFIED ON THE PLANS REFERS TO WORK “TO BE PERFORMED”

The following pertain specifically to Drawing EL101:

- (8). **Q:** In corridor 036 (next to Office 054) there is 8’ Lighting Fixture, but this fixture does not have any designation. Please advise.

**A:** Fixture is S1. As legend indicates, the S1 fixture is called out in various sizes.

- (9). **Q:** In corridor 019 there are Lighting Fixtures, but these fixtures don’t have any designation. Should these fixture type “D”? Please advise.

**A:** Please refer to legend sheet A108 for light fixture types. Corridor 019 Identifies recessed CAN DWN light and wall MTD perimeter light.

- (10). **Q:** In corridor 015 (next to Unassigned 011 & Storage 010) there are Lighting Fixtures, but these fixtures don’t have any designation. Please advise.

**A:** Please refer to legend on sheet A108 for light fixture types. 011, 010, 005B, 015 are all provided.

(11). **Q:** The drawing A408, section view 1, calls for a “SLIGHT RISE @FRONT and REAR.” Given the integral bowl design, this is Problematic as the material will not bend. If you would like, we Can build up the front, sides and/or rear edges (referred to as a No-drip edge”), but it will increase the cost.

**A:** A408 has been revised to read “No Drip Edge”.

(12). **Q:** Material used is ½” thickness for the countertop as ¾” is not Available for Corian. This same thickness material will be used for the apron, as well, with the specified plywood backing.

**A:** ½” will be allowed. A408 has been revised.

(13). **Q:** Will the plumbing remain exposed, or is there an enclosure? If there is an enclosure, what material will it be made of?

**A:** Plumbing will remain exposed.
