- Q1. There is a requirement (C.3.23) for a lab litigation package for each positive drug test result. There is no request for a price for this lab litigation package. Are you requesting a price for this? Or do you want this cost amortized into the cost of the controlled substance screening?
- A1. Cost should be incorporated into your bid.
- Q2. There is a requirement for the Contractor to provide specimen collection at Contractor facilities. Will you no longer be utilizing the DC Public Works collection facility at 2000 14th Street, NW, Wash DC?
- A2. No, the purpose of this contract is for a contractor to provide a facility for testing.
- Q3. There is no mention of management of the random testing process including maintaining rosters of employees eligible for random testing and actual random selections and notifications of those selected for random testing. Is there not a requirement for this process? Do you request a price for this process?
- A3. Cost should be incorporated into your bid.
- Q4. C.3.17.2 requests screening for other controlled substances when approved in writing by COTR, there is no request for pricing for testing for "other controlled substances". Do you request pricing for testing for "other controlled substances".
- A4. Yes, cost should be incorporated into your bid.
- Q5. C.3.18.4 retests for split specimens. There is no request for pricing for retests. Do you request pricing for retests for split specimens?
- A5. Yes, cost should be incorporated into your bid.
- Q6. Other than the pricing information, and disclosure of lab certifications and collection site location - are you requesting any proposal narrative? If so, is there a requested format for this proposal narrative?
