**SUBJECT:** Implementation of Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1990 Transferring the Function of Providing Counseling for D.C. Government Employees to the D.C. Office of Personnel


**ORIGINATING AGENCY:** Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the District of Columbia by sections 422(6) and 422(12) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, as amended, D.C. Code sections 1-242(6) and 1-242(12) (1987 Repl. Vol.), and in accordance with the "Governmental Reorganization Procedures Act of 1981," D.C. Law 4-42, D.C. Code section 1-299.1, *et seq.* (1987 Repl. Vol.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. There is hereby established, in the Executive Branch of the government of the District of Columbia, under the supervision of the Director, D.C. Office of Personnel, an Employee Assistance Program, in accordance with Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1990, which is attached to this Order.
2. The function with respect to a counseling program for troubled employees of the District government vested in the Department of Human Services by Reorganization Order No. 3 of 1980 is hereby transferred to the D.C. Office of Personnel.
3. The Director, D.C. Office of Personnel, is authorized to organize the personnel and property of the D.C. Office of Personnel to fulfill the function transferred by the plan.
4. No positions, property, records or unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations or other funds available relating to the function assigned herein are to be transferred to the D.C. Office of Personnel.

5. Effective Date: This Order, implementing Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1990, shall become effective immediately.

## Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1990

Pursuant to the provisions of the "Governmental Reorganization Procedures Act of 1981," D.C. Law 4-42 and the provisions of Section 422(12) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, as amended, the Mayor of the District of Columbia prepared and submitted to the Council of the District of Columbia on October 10, 1990 the following Reorganization Plan. It was deemed approved by virtue of the Council having taken no action to disapprove it. It transfers the function of the "troubled employees" program of the Department of Human Services to the D.C. Office of Personnel. The program provides comprehensive employee assistance services to District government employees through confidential assessment, counseling and referral services.

### I. Purpose

This plan transfers the function of providing a counseling program for troubled employees of the District of Columbia government from the Department of Human Services to the D.C. Office of Personnel.

### II. Transfer of Function

The function with respect to a counseling program for troubled employees of the District government vested in the Department of Human Services by Reorganization Order No. 3 of 1980 is hereby transferred to the D.C. Office of Personnel.

### III. Organization

The Mayor is authorized to organize the personnel and property of the D.C. Office of Personnel to fulfill the function transferred by the plan.

### IV. Effective Date

This Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1990 shall become effective pursuant to the promulgation of an executive order of the Mayor establishing the same no later than thirty (30) calendar days after this plan has been approved in accordance with § 422(12) of the District of Columbia Self-Government and Governmental Reorganization Act, Public Law 93-198, D.C. Code § 1-242(12) (1987) or October 1, 1990, whichever comes later.
