

Solicitation DCCB-2007-R-0030 is hereby amended to provide responses to offeror's questions: Q1. In C.3.3.3, is a phlebotomist required to do the specimen collections, even though buccal swabs are the primary means of collection and blood is very rarely collected? Could specimen collector be substituted for phlebotomist? A1. No, the phlebotomist can not be substituted. Specimens must be collected by a phlebotomist. Q2. In C.3.3.4, how many Special Projects were held last year? For how many hours did Special Projects last? A2. Last year there were no Special Projects, however Special Projects would be at a minimum of 8 eight hours. Q3. In C.3.5.3, how long does the lab need to hold specimens for incomplete (partial) cases and how long for complete (test result issued) cases? A3. The lab shall hold specimens until informed by the Child Support Services Division to dispose of the specimens. Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document is referenced in Item 9A or 10A remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

<p>Q4. In C.3.5.5, how many expert witness testimony appearances were required last year?</p> <p>A4. Last year there were no expert witness testimonies requested.</p> <p>Q5. In C.3.6.2, how many second tests were required last year? Additionally, who pays for the costs of these secondary tests- the Child Support Enforcement Division?</p> <p>A5. At this time we do not have a count of how many second tests were request last year, however, the requesting party would pay for the secondary test.</p> <p>Q6. For the non IV-D case, would Child Support collect the money up front from the clients, and then the lab bills Child Support for the payment, or is the lab responsible for collecting all funds from non IV-D clients before the draw is performed?</p> <p>A6. A response is not currently available if one becomes available prior the closing date an additional amendment will be issued.</p> <p>Q7. Regarding F.3 and question 4 in Amendment I, our test reports are prepared in a specialized computer program that is neither Excel or Microsoft Word. In order to meet the requirement the requirement for a soft/electronic copy, would a scanned image of the signed report in Adobe Acrobat be acceptable?</p> <p>A7. This would be acceptable.</p> <p>Q8. In I.8.4 you list \$5000, 000 per occurrence for Umbrella/Excess Liability Insurance. Could this amount be reduced Since the laboratory does not receive any money in advance of the work being done? That is, we collect the sample, Perform the analysis, and then submit the invoice.</p> <p>A8. No, this amount can be reduced.</p> <p>Q9. In Attachment J.1.1 after the table that lists the hourly pay rates, there is a section that details benefits. For the Health And Welfare of \$3.01 per hour, is this included in the wage rates in the chart or is this in addition to the wage rates?
