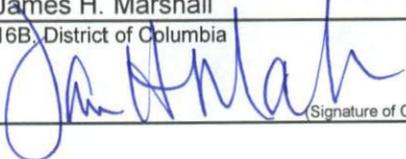
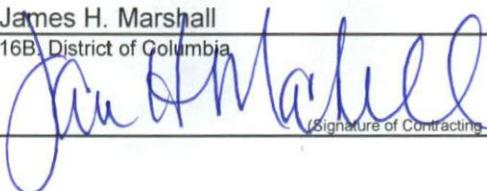

**M.3.1.2.a** This evaluation factor considers the Offeror's technical expertise and capacity to provide the required services.

**M.3.1.2.b** This evaluation factor considers the Offeror's primary operating facility, staff and organization including the Offeror's key personnel and their expertise and experience, the Offeror's IT system and technology to be used in the performance of the required services. This factor will also consider the Offeror's Quality Assurance policies and internal controls and the use of these policies and controls to ensure the effective, accurate delivery of the required services including the SDU related supporting requirements.

**M.3.1.3 Factor C - Past Performance (20 Points Maximum)**

**M.3.1.2.a** This evaluation factor considers the Offeror's past performance and experience with operating an SDU with a collection volume equal to or greater than that of the District.

**M.3.1.2.b** This evaluation factor considers the Offeror's experience with transitioning an SDU from a preceding vendor or a State program, the Offeror's overall experience with providing services similar in size and scope as those described in Section C, and the Offeror's

performance evaluation information and statistical data provided by or concerning the Offeror's delivery of services similar in size and scope of that anticipated by the District.

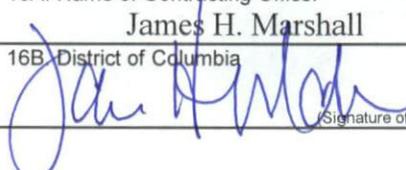

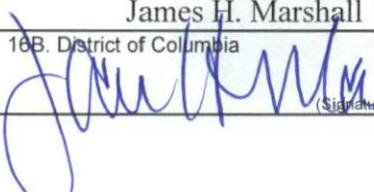
