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**Question #2:** Are you looking for a fixed price for a turn-key operation which includes the rental and the day to day operations for managing the slide?

**Response:** Yes, fixed price turn-key operation which shall include rental and day to day operations for managing the slide.

**Question #3:** Will someone other than the winning bidder be responsible for 24 hour security at the site for the entire duration?

**Response:** Yes, the DC Government will provide 24 hour security at the site.

**Question #4:** Will this be a free amenity to the public? If not, would you be willing to accept a % of the gross revenues derived from the operation?

**Response:** The snow slide shall be a free amenity to the public.

**Question #5:** What are the proposed hours of operation?

**Response:** The hours of operation of the snow slide shall be Friday, Saturday, and Sundays from noon to 5:00pm, and on Monday, January 20, 2014 (MLK Holiday). The hours of operation for the winter lights shall be daily from 4:45pm to 6:00am.

**Question #6:** The IFB talks about the Living Wage Act of 2006. What is the minimum wage that we have to pay any employees?

**Response:** Based on the Living Wage Act of 2006, the living wage rate is \$12.50 effective January 1, 2010.

**Question #7:** When will we receive the budget for what money is available for this project?

**Response:** The District has determined the range of this procurement to be \$125,000 to \$150,000.

**Question #8:** The beginning date for the lights/slide to be operational, and date the equipment is to be removed?

**Response:** See response to question #1 above for the beginning date. All equipment must be removed no later than Friday, February 22, 2014.

**Question #9:** Are the hours of operation for the ice slide and holiday lights different? If so, what are the hours of operation for both?

**Response:** See response to question #5 above.

**Question #10:** The budget allotted for this project?

**Response:** See response to question #7 above.

**Question #11:** As Site #1 being our main goal, what are the dimensions of all 3 sites shown during the pre-bid?

**Response:** Sites #1 and #2 are approximately 80' x 40'. Site #3 is approximately 80' x 20'.

**Question #12:** Due to limited utilities, is a propane generator an option?

**Response:** Yes.
