

Question #3: The RFP lists two different sets of instructions for this: 1. The Solicitation, Offer, and Award cover page (1 original + 5 copies); and 2) Page 39 L.2.1 (1 original + 3 copies). How many copies of the technical and price proposal would you like submitted?

Response: Offerors shall submit one (1) original and five (5) copies of its technical and price proposals.

Question #4: The pricing form provides only one CLIN per year. Our proposed team will be composed of several professionals, each with differing hourly rates. How can we show different rates for multiple positions on the pricing form?

Response: Offerors may add additional Contract Line Item No's. (CLIN) to show multiple positions, proposed labor hours, proposed hourly labor rates, and total estimated price for each position. Offerors shall number each additional CLIN as follows: 0001A, 0001B, 0001C, etc.

Question #5: Paragraph M.3.2 of the solicitation indicates hourly rates will be analyzed as part of the price evaluation process. The pricing form indicates that we are to submit labor hours as well. How are labor hours evaluated?

Response: Proposed labor hours are not evaluated for scoring during the initial evaluation process, but may be addressed during any discussions.

Question #6: The pricing form indicates that we are to provide labor hours for each of the five years of the contract. The mix and number of labor hours per position will vary from year to year based upon the progress of the project. How can we estimate labor hours by position by year without a project schedule?

Response: The District's owner's representative will assist with the full development of the project schedule, so offerors shall use their best judgment in their responses given the content of the RFP.

Question #7: Paragraph L.3.4.1 of the solicitation requires offerors to list all contracts for the past five years. Our firm provides in excess of \$600 million of owner's representative services a year from 100 offices in 35 countries. Assembling a complete list of contracts will be time consuming. Can we provide a representative cross section of projects instead?

Response: Yes.

Question #8: The Solicitation, Offer and Award form indicates the solicitation number as DCEB-2015-R-0003, but the headers on the remaining pages of the solicitation indicate DCEB-2015-R-0001. Which one is correct?

Response: DCEB-2015-R-0003.

Question #9: The pricing forms ask for a total of proposed hours for each year and a single hourly rate. If our yearly lump sum price includes a mix of labor rates, what number should go in that column?

Response: See response to Question #4 above.

Question #10: Also related to the pricing forms in B.3, Section G.10 refers to ceilings for specified hourly rates in section B.3. Section B.3, however is silent on the issue.

Response: This is correct. Offerors are required to insert the proposed number of labor hours, hourly labor rate and total estimated price in the designated fields. The ceilings for specified hourly rates will be mutually agreed upon prior to award.

Question #11: Regarding Section L.5, are all offers posted online or just for the award winner?

Response: Just the award winner.

Question #12: Will there be an amendment issued with answers to questions posted by other interested contractors?

Response: Yes.

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Question #13: Page 1 of the 'Main Document' (Solicitation, Offer, and Award), item 9 states that "Sealed offers in original and 5 copies" of the proposal need to be submitted, whereas, in Section L.2.1 of the RFP, it states that "one original and three (3) copies of the written proposals" shall be submitted. Please verify the quantity required for submission.

Response: See response to Question #3 above.

Question #14: Section C.5.1.2 states: Coordinate with supporting departments/functions/entities (internal and external to DMPED) to manage VMP and the project, from entitlements through site development (base paving), through vertical construction, through scheduling and leading meetings. Draft and present weekly report to DMPED on coordination activities. Does the vertical construction described in this section only refer to the vertical construction DMPED and the District are responsible for, e.g. community center and park facilities, or does it also include the vertical construction on the individual pads that the developers are responsible for?

Response: The vertical construction in Section C.5.1.2 includes the vertical construction DMPED and the District are responsible for, e.g. community center and park facilities, as well as limited coordination related to the vertical construction on the individual pads that the developers are responsible for.

Question #15: The cover page states that proposers should submit an original and five (5) copies, while page 39 states "One original and three (3) copies of the written proposals". Please confirm which is correct.

Response: See response to Question #3 above.

Question #16: The RFP states that the offeror needs to include labor hours, hourly labor rate and total estimated price for the base and option years. Could you let us know if DMPED needs the offeror to include a blended rate and hours or individual rates and hours for proposed staff included in the proposal? Please confirm.

Response: Please include individual rates and hours for proposed staff in proposal. Also, see response to Question #4 above.
