

Response to Offeror Questions

Q1. The inside width of the trailer is 6ft. If the shelves are 2ft 2" on one side and 2ft. 2" on the other side that leaves a pathway of 1'8" wide to carry equipment. This 1'8" pathway will not allow a tent carry cart over the wheel base and forces a tie down of the tent system that weighing between 600lbs to 800lbs in the very rear of the trailer. If sufficient weight is not placed over the wheel base; the trailer could sway and possibly topple during transport. Are these the correct specifications for the shelving?

A1. The trailer specifications specify a 26-inch shelf on the driver's side of the trailer only, not on both sides. A copy of the trailer specifications is attached to this modification.

Q2. The specifications call for 60lbs per square foot shelving rating. Custom 60lbs shelves can be built to handle this at additional cost just to hold light ticks, traffic cones, garden hoses, etc. Since the stated inside height is only 6' tall it is suggested that the District add another 6" to the inside height of the trailer so most workers can stand up,

A2. Section B.2 is revised to read as follows:

"- 18' Trailer Dual Axle w. Ramp Rear Door, Side Door, Adjustable Metal Shelving to accommodate equipment Bins/Binders, 2,275 lbs empty, 4,725 lb. capacity, 7,000 lbs GVW w. Extended Tongue; Minimum Interior Space Required = 15' L x 6' W x 6' 6" H or 540ft³, and utilize a 2-5/16" Ball size. The roof should be made of material that allows light to pass through. The floor shall be equipped with adjustable tie-down points for heavy equipment.

Shelving should be made of aluminum of sufficient gauge to load to 30 pounds per square foot. All shelving should be height adjustable without the use of specialized tools or equipment.

Anchor rings should be attached within the trailer to secure loads from moving/shifting."

Q3. Section B, Line #0004 lists "Containment Basin – Hand Sprayers for patient self decon". Is the end user agency requesting pricing for containment basin and hand sprayers together on this line?

A3. Yes; Section B.2 Contract Line Item No. 0004 is revised to read as follows:

Q4. Section B.2, Line #0009 lists a "Hot Water Heater" – What is the BTU requirement?

A.4 The BTU output should be sufficient to supply the tents with hot water for decon operations.

Q5. Line #0034 lists "Traffic Cones" - What is the desired height and markings for the traffic cones?

A.5 The minimum height for the traffic cones are 28 inch non-reflective.

Q.6 Section C.3.6 states "The Contractor shall deliver all trailers and tents to DCFD's Fleet Maintenance Facility located at 1101 Half Street S.W., Washington, DC 20001." Does the end user agency want the equipment shipped separately or in the trailers?

A.6 All equipment should be delivered together in the trailers.
