

B.3.2 The contractor shall provide all fixed unit bid prices for each CLIN item specified in Section B.4 Price Schedule of this solicitation. Any product item specified by manufacturer's name and stock number is used for descriptive purposes, unless stated otherwise in the technical specification, and is used to maintain a definite standard of quality and style. The contractor should provide a comparable product item that satisfies the minimum technical specification of this solicitation.

L.4 BRAND NAME OR APPROVED EQUAL

L.4.2 As used in this clause, the term "brand name" includes identification of products by make and model.

L.4.3 If items called for by this Invitation for Bids have been identified in the schedule by a "brand name or equal" description, such identification is intended to be descriptive, but not restrictive, and is to indicate the quality and characteristics of products that will be satisfactory. Bids offering "equal" products will be considered for award if such products are clearly identified in the bids and are determined by the District to be equal in all material respects to the brand name products referenced in the Invitation for Bids.

L.4.4 Unless the bidder clearly indicates in his bid that he is offering an "equal" product, his bid shall be considered as offering a brand name product referenced in the Invitation for Bids.

L.4.5 If the bidder proposes to furnish an "equal" product, the brand name, if any, of the product to be furnished shall be inserted in the space provided in the Invitation for Bids, or such product shall be otherwise clearly identified in the bid.

L.4.6 The evaluation of bids and the determination as to equality of the product offered shall be the responsibility of the District and will be based on information furnished by the bidder or identified in his bid as well as other information reasonably available to the purchasing authority. **CAUTION TO BIDDERS:** The District is not responsible for locating or securing any information which is not identified in the bid and not reasonably available to the District.

- L.4.7** Accordingly, to insure that sufficient information is available, the bidder must furnish as a part of his bid all descriptive material (such as cuts, illustrations, drawings, or other information) necessary for the District to (i) determine the product offered meets the requirements of the Invitation for Bids, and (ii) establish exactly what the bidder proposes to furnish and what the District would be binding itself to purchasing by making an award. The information furnished may include specific reference to information previously furnished or to information otherwise available to the District.
- L.4.8** If the bidder proposes to modify a product so as to make it conform to the requirements of the Invitation for Bids, he shall (i) include in his bid a clear description of such proposed modifications, and (ii) clearly mark any descriptive material to show the proposed modifications.
- L.4.9** Modifications proposed after bid opening to make a product conform to a brand name product referenced in the Invitation for Bids will not be considered.
