ATTACHMENT A TO AMENDMENT #2 TO SOLICITATION NO. DCFB-2011-B-0157

- 1) In the Addendum # 1 it is stated alternate window manufacturers must submit a complete product review with all details to the design engineer as well as all test reports 10 working days before bid. Since the new bid date is 7/28/11, there is not 10 working days available to provide the required information for review. Please advise if the bid date will be extended to provide us the required 10 working days to prepare and submit the required package.

The bid opening date and time is hereby extended from July 28, 2011 by 2:00 p.m. local time to August 11, 2011 by 2:00 p.m. local time.

- 2) Section K.2 of the Solicitation states Buy American Certification requirements. The specified Norwood window company is located in Canada and the windows will be manufactured in Canada. Are you waiving this requirement?

For clarification Section K.2 of the solicitation does not refer to the Buy American Act. The Buy American Act Certification is Section K.7. Please note that over 50% of the manufactured construction materials are produced or manufactured in the United States which makes the requirement in compliance with the Buy American Act. Moreover, the North American Free Trade Agreement between the United States, Mexico and Canada disallows domestic protection legislation between the parties such as the Buy American Act.

- 3) Previous fire engine window replacements projects have included Kolb & Kolbe wood windows among other US based wood window manufacturers. Is there any particular and unique reason why we should provide windows manufactured by Norwood?

The District's requirement in the solicitation is clear. Bidders responding to the solicitation should bid accordingly.
