

**SECTION L - INSTRUCTIONS, CONDITIONS AND NOTICES TO BIDDERS**

**L.25 SPECIAL STANDARD OF RESPONSIBILITY:**

**L.25.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Bidders or their proposed subcontractors shall have experience specializing in the design, fabrication, and installation of integrated correctional facility security and communications control systems for a minimum of ten (10) years.

**L.25.2 Bidder shall submit the following:**

**L.25.2.1** Bidders shall provide a list of at least five (5) Federal, State, County and/or Government Judicial Installations that are completed and operational wherein the security equipment and services meet the following criteria:

**L.25.2.1.1** The minimum period of operation (following final completion) shall be six (6) month with at least two (2) of the ten facilities having been operational for not less than two (2) years.

**L.25.2.1.2** For each project listed provide the following information:

- i. Name and location of the project
- ii. Type of project (Federal, State or County Court, Federal, State or County Detention Facility).
- iii. Size of the project, include the following as a minimum: total project construction costs, total number of cells, total project square footage, type of each product and service provided and total quantity of each product and service provided.
- iv. Date of Final Completion and Occupancy.
- v. Description of work provided and the contract value. Include security level of the products, and a description of the products provided.
- vi. Contact name, address, and telephone numbers of the following:

- a). Owner.
- b). Architect and Engineer.

**L.25.3 Bids submitted in response to this IFB shall be deemed non-responsible and shall be rejected if the bidder fails to submit with his bid the above information that is required by Section L.25.**
