

Solicitation No.: DCGW-2008-R-0018

Q1: On the cover sheet of the RFP (item #12) it states that if the offer is accepted within 150 calendar days from the date of receipt that the offeror agrees upon the price set in the cost proposal submitted. However, on page 41 (L.15) the RFP states that the time period is within 180 days. Which date should be considered firm?

A1: This question needs to be answered by OCP

Q2: On page 40 (L.11) the RFP states that an electronic redacted version of the proposal must be submitted. However, it is unclear if this redacted version needs to be submitted later or with the hard copy full proposal on June 14th. Can you please clarify?

A2: This question needs to be answered by OCP, but I suspect that it would be preferred to get it at the same time.

Q3: Is there any further information about the number/location of schools that will be added in subsequent option years?

A3: At this time, there is no additional information about the number or location of schools that will be added in the option years.

Q4: Is there any information about the name and number of evidenced based interventions that will be added to the program each year?

A4: Currently there are plans to implement LifeSkills Training, Primary Project, and Second Step, beginning in the fall. Additional evidence-based programs will be added incrementally as they are identified and as resources allow. No more than four additional programs will be added each year.

Q5: In addressing pricing information for 0001, 0001A and 0001B, can you clarify if the DC START program is the evidence based program in addition to there being Evidence Based Programs that will be implemented in DC START? In other words, it looks like with the option years, there will be 14 evidence based programs. Is this correct?
