QUESTION AND ANSWERS
DPR INSTALLATION OF SPORTS LIGHTING AT BANNEKER TENNIS COURT

1. Q: We visited the site and found no existing lighting around the tennis court as outlined in the solicitation. How do we proceed?

A: This is correct. There are no existing lights on the field at Banneker. General contract language that included "Removal" language was used in the specifications. Attached is a schematic for light installation and location.

2. Q: Can you tell us the amount of the bonds that will be required to complete the project?

A: A bid bond in the amount of 5% of your bid price is required with all bids over \$100,000.00. If a bidder fails to provide the required bid guarantee, such failure will require rejection of the bid.

3. Q: Can the bid bond be paid in the form of Cashier's Check or Letter of Credit?

A: The acceptable forms of bid guarantee is listed in Section L.16 of the solicitation and are as follows:

- a. A bond provided by a surety in accordance with 27 DCMR Chapter 2708
- b. A certified check or irrevocable letter of credit issued by an insured financial institution in the equivalent amount of the security, or
- c. United States government securities that are assigned to the District which pledge the full faith and credit of the United States.

4. Q: In the attachments to the solicitation (Instructions to Bidders) it states that a Performance Bond is required for contracts over \$100,000.00 in a penal amount of 100% of the contract. See Article 12.B. Please clarify.

A: The Payment and Performance bond is required once the contract is awarded.

5. Q: Can the lighting footing be made outside the court fencing?

A: Lights will be placed outside the fence line (Correction made from walk through)

6. Q: Is there adequate connected load available from PEPCO?

A: Being that this is new service, adequate power cannot be verified.
