

**INSTALLATION OF SPORT LIGHTING AT TRINIDAD Q & A  
DCHA-2010-B-0185**

1) The Amendment #1 shows the Musco Control System. Where on site would this go?? **Site to be determined by contractor, with final approval by DPR**

#2) Scope calls for a new metered service from Pepco. Will this be a new meter installed beside the outside panel beside the Musco Control System. If so can we just stub out for Pepco or does it have to go to a certain Pepco pole. So it is equal for bid purposes.

**The Contractor can likely stub out from existing PEPCO service. Final approval and site specific layout to be determined by PEPCO.**

#3) Scope calls for the removal of 10 poles and fixtures. There are 12 existing ones. Please clarify all 12 get removed.

**We are in need of 12 poles for removal, there was a miscount. Please adjust your bid to reflect 12.**

#4) Existing poles and fixtures. Are they to remain GOVT. Property. If so where do they get delivered. If contractor has to dispose of them they need to be disposed of in an environmental correct manner.

**Existing poles shall be removed and disposed of according to local codes.**

#5) Scope calls for the electrical wiring and fixtures?? How does this item relate to the pole and fixture installation?

**I am uncertain of the specific paragraph being mentioned, but I am guessing the mentioned verbiage speaks to removal of existing underground wires and fixtures.**

#6) Since there is no official drawings the permit process might call for an electrical engineered stamped set of drawings showing all wire/conduit. How will this be handled?

**Contractor shall be responsible for all permits and drawings.**
