ATTACHMENT A

RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS RECEIVED FROM A POTENTIAL OFFEROR

Q 1 - Are the people who have been assessed in group one and ready for the July 1st intake currently living in shelters?

A 1 - They all have not been assessed yet. Some are in shelters and some are on the streets.

Q 2 - If consumers do not have Medicaid and are in need of services, will the cost for those services come from the case rate? In other words, should we include the cost of potential services for those individuals and families who do not have insurance?

A 2 - No. Only case management services will be paid for under this solicitation. There are programs within the District that those without Medicaid qualify for. It is the responsibility of the case manager to connect clients to those programs.
