### AMENDMENT NO. 4 – DCKA-2011-B-0059

#### CLARIFICATION TO QUESTIONS NO. 4 AND NO. 5

4. Q - If a DBE bids the project as a prime contractor, do they have to self perform any work or can they simply sub contract everything with other companies.

A – In order for a Prime Contractor to receive DBE Participation credit (whether or not the Prime is a DBE), the work must be performed by a DBE in good standing under the federal requirements for the DBE program. That said, a DBE Prime will receive credit for self-performing the duties, or sub-contracting the work to another certified DBE. Bidders are also reminded that prime contractors (DBE or Non-DBE) are expected to perform 30% of the work with their own organization.

5. Q - Confirm what the levels of both the Bid and the Performance Bond. In the Pre-bid it was stated that the bid bond must include the total of base and all four option years, is this correct? What is the limit of the performance bond (in the same regard)?

A – A bid bond in the amount of 5% of the bid is due with the bid. A performance bond in the amount of 100% is due at contract execution. A payment bond in the amount of 50% is due at contract execution. The payment and performance bond must be submitted for the base year and is renewable each year thereafter when the District exercises each option.
