<b><u>Instructions</u></b>					
1) The Government of the District of Columbia, Office of Contracting and Procurement, on behalf of the District Department of Transportation (DDOT), is soliciting Standard Form 330 from experienced Architect- Engineering firms. The form will be used in selecting a contractor to prepare the District of Columbia Long Range Multi-Modal Transportation Plan (the "Plan"). The desired outcome of the RFQ is to contract with a qualified professional firm or firms to conduct the activities necessary for the completion of the Plan. The Plan will set the long term vision and implementation actions as DDOT continues to build a world class, sustainable transportation system in a growing and evolving city. This includes consolidating all modal studies to have one master multi-modal plan that considers street planning, design, use, funding, regulation, operations, maintenance, education and enforcement. This study will require interaction with all internal, external and community stakeholders, including other District of Columbia agencies and community, civic and business organizations. The final outcome of the Plan will be adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the District of Columbia.					
2) Contractor selection will be in accordance with the provisions of 27 DCMR Chapter 2620 through 2633. A panel of DDOT staff will conduct evaluations and make award recommendations to the Contracting Officer. Final selection will be made by the Contracting Officer in accordance with Title 27 DCMR Chapter 26

3) The evaluation criteria for selection are listed below:

- a) Professional qualifications necessary for satisfactory performance of the required services (staff qualifications) 15 pts
- b) Specialized experience and technical competence 15 pts.
- c) Capacity to accomplish the work in the required time, including the capacity of any sub-contractors (availability/location of key staff) 15 pts
- d) Past performance on contracts with the District, other governmental entities, and private industry in terms of cost control, quality of work and compliance with performance schedules; (firm capability and experience) 20 pts
- e) Project understanding and approach 35 pts

4) Vendors desiring consideration for Architect-Engineer contracts should submit ten (10) copies of their Standard Form 330, Architect-Engineer Qualifications. All vendors desiring consideration for the Architect-Engineer contracts must include all information relating to the firm's qualifications in the standard form. Inclusion by reference to other materials is not acceptable. A digital copy of the submission on CD or USB drive should also be included in the submission package.

5) DDOT will award one fixed price contract to one contractor for a period of performance not exceed 540 days after Notice to Proceed


