

Dear Resident:

I am pleased to announce that the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is continuing the Visitor Parking Pass (VPP) program within your Advisory Neighborhood Commission boundaries.

Enclosed you will find your household's new Visitor Parking Pass. You may begin using this pass immediately; please review the rules printed on the back of the VPP and always remind your guests to return the pass to you at the end of each visit.

It is important to remember that this VPP does not provide an exemption to the Registration of Out of State Automobiles (ROSA) requirements that vehicles must be registered in the District of Columbia within thirty (30) days of residency. A regular visitor to your home during evening hours, when RPP is not in effect, will still need to obtain a ROSA parking exemption from the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).
