

Responses to questions received as of September 20, 2013

For RFP DCKA-2013-R-0138 Plan, Assess, Install Bicycle Parking Racks

- 1.) The revised RFP specifies racks w/a dimension of 36" high X 24" wide; the current racks are 34" X 24" wide. Is a 34" high or 32" high rack acceptable?

Answer: A 34" high rack would be acceptable.

- 2.) The revised RFP specifies that the racks be galvanized with a PVC coating. Will other finish options be considered/acceptable?

Answer: No.

- 3.) Does a joint venture need to be formalized before the RFP is submitted, or can that be done after the contract is awarded?

Answer: Whatever the entity is, that will be awarded the contract, must be a going concern at the time of award. After award, no joint venture can be formed that will be able to legally perform on the contract. This does not pertain to sub-contractors.

- 4.) Since answers to the new round of questions won't be available until just a few days before the new RFP is due, is it possible to extend the deadline for at least an additional week to finalize the proposals?

Answer: Extended to October 1, 2013

- 5.) In the event that we are unable to install in-ground racks, are we able to install rail-mounted racks instead? (Essentially, can we look at the rail racks and in-ground racks as a combined quota with the two rack types being interchangeable?)

Answer: Yes, if approved in advance by DDOT.

- 6.) How will we bill for rack repairs? Will these count as assessments/guidance/an installation?

Answer: At this juncture, DDOT would determine a repair was necessary and subsequently authorize the repairs, at that point, could determine a more definitive repair bill back procedure through modification.
