PROJECT TITLE: Reconstruction of Northbound Kenilworth Avenue, NE

The Government of the District of Columbia, Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP), on behalf of the District Department of Transportation (DDOT) is seeking a contractor to provide a construction schedule and the necessary construction work for the Reconstruction of NB Kenilworth Avenue, NE.

Work under this contract consists of removal and proper disposal of street lighting poles, cables, luminaries, and respective concrete foundations. The removal of these items shall be coordinated with the staged reconstruction of street lighting. Usable material shall be salvaged and delivered to the District storage yard.

Work also includes but not limited to mobilization and demobilization, provision and maintenance of work and storage areas, Engineer's Field Facilities and Employee Training and all other incidentals items required as shown in the contract plans and/or as specified in the Standard Specifications and the Special Provisions.

For the duration of the contract, the Contractor shall be fully responsible for protection against damage of all the utility structures within the contract limits and adjacent thereto. Cost of this protective work shall be reflected and distributed among the contract pay items.

TITLE VI OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964, AS AMENDED:

During the performance of the Contract, the Contractor and any of its subcontractors shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended. This Act provides that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, or be denied the benefits of or be subject to discrimination in federally funded program and activities. See 42 U.S.C. §2000d *et seq.* This Contract is subject to all appropriate Federal Laws, including Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

The commodity code for this project is 913-47-73. This is a FHWA federal funded contract. **There is an 8% DBE subcontracting goal for this project.**

A BID BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF 5% OF THE BID AMOUNT IS REQUIRED.
