

The policy shall provide a \$1,000,000 per occurrence combined single limit for bodily injury and property damage.</p>

2. Workers' Compensation Insurance. The Contractor shall provide Workers' Compensation insurance in accordance with the statutory mandates of the District of Columbia or the jurisdiction in which the contract is performed.

Employer's Liability Insurance. The Contractor shall provide employer's liability insurance as follows: \$500,000 per accident for injury; \$500,000 per employee for disease; and \$500,000 for policy disease limit.

3. Umbrella or Excess Liability Insurance. The Contractor shall provide umbrella or excess liability (which is excess over employer's liability, general liability, and automobile liability) insurance as follows: \$5,000,000 per occurrence, including the District of Columbia as additional insured.

~~6. Professional Liability Insurance (Errors & Omissions). The Contractor shall Provide Professional Liability Insurance (Errors and Omissions) to cover liability resulting from any error or omission in the performance of professional services under this Contract. The policy shall provide limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence for each wrongful act and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate.~~

~~The Contractor shall maintain this insurance for five (5) years following the District's final acceptance of the work performed under this contract.~~

~~1. Crime Insurance (3rd Party Indemnity). The Contractor shall provide a 3rd Party Crime policy to cover the dishonest acts of Contractor's employees which result in a loss to the District. The policy shall provide a limit of \$100,000 per occurrence. This coverage shall be endorsed to name the District of Columbia as joint loss payee, as their interests may appear.~~

~~2. Sexual/Physical Abuse & Molestation. The Contractor shall provide evidence satisfactory to the Contracting Officer with respect to the services performed that it carries \$1,000,000 per occurrence limits; \$2,000,000 aggregate. The policy coverage shall include the District of Columbia as an additional insured. This insurance requirement will be considered met if the general liability insurance includes sexual abuse and molestation coverage for the required amounts.~~

4. ~~Environmental Liability Insurance~~ Contractor's Pollution Liability Coverage. ~~The Contractor shall provide a policy to cover costs associated with bodily injury, property damage and remediation expenses associated with pollution incidents including, but not limited to, mold, asbestos or lead removal.~~ The policy shall provide a minimum of \$1,000,000 in coverage per incident and \$1,000,000 aggregate.

5. Installation-Floater Insurance. For projects not involving structures, the contractor shall provide an installation floater policy with a limit equal to the full contract value. The policy shall cover property while located at the project site, at temporary locations, or in transit; deductibles will be the sole responsibility of the contractor; and name the District of Columbia as the loss payee on the policy, as its interests may appear. A waiver of subrogation in favor of the District of Columbia shall be included.

B. DURATION. The Contractor shall carry all required insurance until all contract work is accepted by the District, and shall carry ~~the required General Liability; any required Professional Liability; and any required Employment Practices Liability insurance~~ listed coverages for five (5) years following final acceptance of the work performed under this contract.
