7	<b>Line no. 0210</b> --- Duratherm Pavement Marking for Crosswalks: 5300 SF There is no detail drawing for the crosswalk design and plans do not indicate which crosswalks.	-The detail for the Duratherm pattern and standard colors are shown on page-4 & 5. Use HERRINGBONE-22 pattern with the following colors:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Yellow - border</li> <li>- Colonial Red - brick pattern</li> </ul>
