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2. **Question** - Since the submission date is May 30, which is a holiday, can you confirm that the actual due date will be May 31st? Will the time due remain the same.

Response - Refer to Amendment No. 1 for new bid submission date.

3. **Question** - Can you confirm whether an in-person interview will be required or if the evaluation of the written

Response - Refer to page 19 of the RFQ.

4. **Question** - Can the requirement for a Civil Engineer with an Associate's degree be waived in favor of equivalent many years of relevant experience in the public and private sector.

Response - No, the District specifically requests this level of expertise for this position.

5. **Question** - Is this for asphalt or concrete paving or both?

Response - The successful Contractor will oversee both asphalt and concrete paving work.

6. **Question** - When would the work actually start? The RFQ says FY15.

Response - Refer to Response to Question 1.

7. **Question** - Is there a contact at DDOT that we can reach out to as we prepare a response to this solicitation?

Response - Prospective Offerors may contact Vallarie Howard, Contract Specialist with any questions.

8. **Question** - General. What is the expected scope of the construction contracts to be managed by the successful Contractor? What is their anticipated duration and cost?

Response - Contract DCKA-2016-Q-0008 has a period of performance with an estimated ceiling of \$10,000,000.00.

9. **Question** - General . Please clarify DDOT's intent under the Scope of Services. Is the Contractor providing staff augmentation and generally performing the duties outlined under Section 4. Scope of Services? Or is it DDOT's intent to issue specific task orders under this IDIQ for CM Services of specific projects?

Response - The successful contractor will provide staff for the required services.

10. **Question** - Section 4. Scope of Basic Services. Item b (10) states the Contractor "shall maintain a current marked set of as-built drawings and specifications." How do these differ from the as-built drawings each construction contractor must maintain and turn over?

Response - The Contractor shall maintain the same drawings as the Construction Contractor.

11. **Question** - Section 4. Scope of Basic Services. Item b (11) states the Contractor "shall submit an IDR, weekly progress reports, and monthly invoices." With what frequency shall the project diary be submitted?

Response - "IDR" is the abbreviation for the Inspectors Daily Report and should be submitted daily.

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12. **Question** - Section 4. Scope of Basic Services, Item b (25). Are "proto calls" the same as "protocols"?

Response - Yes, the section is revised.

13. **Question** - Section 5. Contract. Item i. Will the Contractor be afforded the opportunity to update its list of subcontractors during the period of the contract with DDOT?

Response - Yes, if necessary, however, the 10% DBE goal should be adhered to in determining substitutions.

14. **Question** - Section 6. Key Personnel states "the following key personnel... will be required to be co-located with DDOT personnel at DDOT's headquarters..." Under whose direction will the Contractor's personnel perform work, DDOT's or the Contractor's?

Response - The Contractor's personnel will perform under the direction of its designated management. However, DDOT's Project Manager has overall supervision of the contractor and is available for assistance. Any changes, additions or deletions to the work or key personnel will be approved by the Contracting Officer.

15. **Question** - Section 6. Key Personnel. Item (a). Are any engineering degrees other than Civil Engineering acceptable for the Resident Engineer?

Response - No, the District specifically request this level of expertise of this position.

16. **Question** - Section 6. Key Personnel. Item (b). Are any engineering degrees other than Civil Engineering acceptable for the Office of Engineer/Senior Inspector?

Response - No, the District specifically requests this level of expertise for this position.
