<p>Amendment 006 was issued in error and is rescinded. The Contract Officer has changed to P. Thomas Gard. The bid submission date is rescheduled for March 9, 2018.</p> <p><u>DDOT response to questions following the issuance of Amendment 5</u></p> <p><u>Question:</u></p> <p>On Amendment #5, the only asphalt surface line item is Repair-Replace HMA Surface Course, 12.5mm (line item 0075 in the base year). According to the DDOT Standard Specifications, section 408 – Repair-Replace Bituminous Surfaces and Bases, this line item includes cutting out and removing defective pavement, as well as replacing it. This line item is for point repairs, or repairs of pavement in areas that are not being milled and overlaid.</p> <p>Given that there are milling line items in the bid, we assume that the intent was for DDOT to include a surface paving line item for the 2" asphalt overlay. Such a line item would be HMA Surface Course,</p>					

12.5mm, using DDOT Standard Specifications section 402, instead. For example, line item 0220 in the Amendment #4 line items.


Can you please confirm that the intent of this line item is to be used as asphalt overlay, rather than removal and replacement of existing surface pavement?

Response:

Following clarification is provided to Pay Item ID "408002 – Repair-Replace HMA Surface Course 12.5 mm":

The Contractor shall furnish and install 12.5 mm HMA surface course per ton for various applications such as roadway resurfacing following milling, trench repair for utility cuts, asphalt sidewalk/bike path patchwork etc. This pay Item does not include milling, tack coat or removal of pavement/sidewalk for which separate pay items are available in the pay item schedule.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document is referenced in Item 9A or 10A remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
