

Amendment No. 6 Clarification of Q&A No. 6: There appears to be a mistaken impression. DDOT is not requesting ten (10) projects. The instructions say up to ten (10) projects. The quantity of experience does not trump the quality of the experience. What did your firm do to be rated as the most highly qualified. For example, if three (3) projects will fully document your firm’s qualifications as most highly qualified, provide only those projects.</p> <p>5. Amendment No. 6 Clarification of Q&A 44 & 51 – DDOT has no objection to making past performance materials an attachment.</p> <p>6. Amendment No. 6 Clarification of Q&A 16 – Answer provided in No. 16 remains unchanged. In addition the following is provided. DDOT cannot opine as to the breath and scope of all of the various state reciprocity arrangements. It is the responsibility of the Consultant to ensure that its personnel are properly licensed to perform their assigned professional duties in the District of Columbia as required by the applicable District of Columbia Professional Practice Act.</p> <p>7.
