

1. Question: Has there been any Amendments?  
Answer: One previous amendment to extend the solicitation was issued November 20, 2009.
2. Question: Is it possible to see the previous award?  
Answer: This solicitation combines the District's needs for parts and service. This is a new requirement. Previously the District only had formal agreements for repair parts.
3. Question: Does the request include preventative maintenance and if so, how should we show in pricing?  
Answer: This request does not include preventative maintenance.
4. Question: How much service was used last year?  
Answer: The service used last year is estimated at \$10,500.00.
5. Question: How many tows?  
Answer: Only four (4) tows were recorded last year.
6. Question: What are some of your expectations? How do you see the relationship working?  
Answer: The agency, as with all contracting entities on behalf of the District, expects high quality service in accordance with established procedural guidelines – See Section C of the solicitation. Additionally, the District expects a professional working relationship with the contracting entity via effective communication in following the established guidelines based on the agreed upon terms specific to the services requested.
7. Question: Do you have a list of specific vehicles? Year/ Make/Model?  
Answer: The majority of our vehicles ranges from 2002 to 2009 Dodge.
