

14. A. Responses to additional Offerors' questions are provided below.

Q1. DC University – It's listed at 52 visits. Can you confirm what services should be provided for the 52 visits?

A1. The University expects Scheduled/Routine Services to be provided.

Q2. Would the District consider an award to 1 contractor if the price/experience of the contractor were right?

A2. Refer to section M.1.1 of the solicitation. It is possible that the same contractor can be awarded more than one award.

Q3. Since it isn't our total discretion as to whether or not we mow, in say, a rain occurrence, would we still be responsible to the 1/3 rule in terms of how much of the turf we can cut at one time? i.e. If the COR dictates that we should not mow at that time and the turf becomes too tall, will we still have to double cut 1/3 and 1/3 as part of the contract requirements, or will we be permitted to bill for the additional cutting?

A3. The goal is to maintain the approved schedule as much as possible. The contractor shall obtain written approval by the COTR for any additional cuts prior to providing service.

Q4. Can more than one Prime list the same company as their subcontractor for this proposal for exact Wards? Ex. Company A and Company B are bidding and they both are using Company C as their subcontractor for exact Wards.

A4. The selection of a subcontractor is at the discretion of the vendor, subject to provision in Section I.7 Subcontracts.

Q5. Ward 2, OY2 shows, under Unscheduled Service, 8, 8A & 8B however Base, OY1, OY3, OY4 only shows 8A and 8B. Should there be an 8 on OY2 which states Mulching as described in section C.3.13.

A5. For Ward 2, Delete subCLIN 8 Mulching under CLIN 1002AC. Pricing is only required for subCLINs 8A and 8B.

Q6. Confirm total number of acres for Ward 1.

A6. The total estimated number of acres is 60.297. Refer to Sections L.2.1.1.F and L.18 regarding the Offeror's responsibility to familiarize itself with each of the locations. Offerors are required to price each location. The total price should be based on the total for each of the locations in the ward.
