

SOLID WASTE HAULING AND DISPOSAL SERVICES

Question 1 a) Has the District's Disposal Agreement with Fairfax been amended to increase the amount of trash that the District can take to Fairfax to 200,000 tons? If so, please send the amendment.

Answer The District is in the process of amending the Agreement with Fairfax. The agreement has not been finalized and is unavailable.

b) If the Disposal Agreement has not been amended and if 200,000 tons of trash is anticipated, does that mean that all of the combustible trash above the 125,000 ton ceiling will be sent to King George landfill each year?

Answer The 200,000 ton of trash will be going to Fairfax.

c) If up to 100,000 tons of trash could be sent to the King George landfill each year, why will the District assume only a total quantity of one (1) run at the hauling price to the King George landfill when it calculates the total price for CLINs 0005, 1005 and 2005 as stated in the response to Question 11 in Amendment No. 2?

Answer It would be a very rare event to haul combustible solid waste to King George therefore it is estimated that the number of run would be one (1).

Question 2 a) The District did not provide a response to Question 1(a) that asked the amount of combustible trash that went to Fairfax E/RRF in each of the past five years.

Answer Current numbers are unavailable.

b) The number of tons of combustible trash that went to a disposal facility other than Fairfax in each of the past five years.
