

RESPONSES TO BIDDERS QUESTIONS:

Q1. How many miles do you do a year. (national average is 12,000-15000)?

What has historically been the average annual mileage by aggregate groups:

A1. On average under 10,000 miles annually.

Q2. In the bid it states that you want government tags, however only gov't agencies can apply for gov't tags. So we could provide all the paper work for you but you would actually have to get the tags yourself. DC changed the laws a couple year ago and we can no longer do them. Is that going to be a problem?

A2. Per DMV, there will not be a problem for the leasing companies to purchase government tags for government vehicles. The tags will only be one (1) year registration and would have to be renewed on a yearly basis.

Q3. Item 0004, Ford Escape is a 5 passenger vehicle, though item description calls for a 7 passenger.

A3. The description for Ford Escape or equal (now CLIN 0005) is corrected to read 5 passenger.

Q4. Item 0009, call for a 2 passenger van (Express or equal) both Chevrolet & Ford make an 8,12 or 15 passenger van, but not a two passenger. Could this be a typo, and you may be looking for a 12 passenger?

A4. The description for Chevrolet Express or equal (now CLIN 0010) is corrected to read 12 passenger van.

Q5. Item 0014, pickup 4x4, 5 passenger, regular cab. A regular cab pickup as a seating capacity of 3. Is this a regular cab 3 passenger or an extended cab 5 passenger?

A5. The description for the Chevrolet Silverado or equal (now CLIN 0015) is corrected to read extended cab 4x4 pickup.

Q6. What is the maximum mileage on the vehicle the District will accept upon delivery?

A6. 600 miles

Q7. Can you provide me with a wiring diagram for equipment the District plans to install? Specifically, how it ties into electrical system(s). Also, does the District guarantee that the equipment installation will not void the manufacturer's warranty?




