

The number of trained personnel per collection is subject to change depending on the District's need.

TASK B2 RESIDENTIAL DROP OFF LOCATION FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Care Environmental Corporation will provide one 20' long x 8' wide fire protected Household Hazardous Waste Storage Building for installation on County owned property having the following requirements: (1) properly secured, (2) black topped consisting of minimum space requirement of 2000 square feet, and (3) a minimum of 100 amp electric service available. Care Environmental Corp will supply two (2) men every Saturday, from 9:00 am through 1:00 pm and every Wednesday from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm (excluding holidays), to receive, identify, consolidate and package Household Hazardous Waste, in preparation for transportation and ultimate recycling and/or disposal of Household Hazardous Waste from County Residents. Care will also supply door to door service for residents of the County that are disabled or Senior Citizens with no means of transportation to the facility. Care will provide a toll free number for all Prince William County residents to call. Pre-registration for waste pick-up services for special residents will be required. Camera ready artwork will be supplied to the County for advertising purposes. Care will also perform free workshops to County residents and County owned conditionally exempt Small Quantity Generators as well as training to County employees. Care will also have a member present at each citizen advisory meeting held in order to clarify any questions regarding the management of Household Hazardous Waste.

Upon the potential opening of the non-regulated Household/Universal Hazardous Waste Transfer facility, Care Environmental Corp proposes the following Cost proposal to Prince William County.
