

Responses to Bidders Questions:

Q1. Under the new solicitation, there are penalty clauses with respect to timely deliveries; how will these penalties be evaluated for accessing when there will be two contractors supplying salt on this contract?

A1. The District may award 1 or 2 contracts as a result of this solicitation. It is not the District's intent to use two vendors at the same time. Penalties will be accessed by date order is placed with the vendor and when the order is completed.

Q2. This bid will allow for two vendors. If one vendor is delivering to all locations and the second vendor receives an order and arrives at your facility and can not deliver because the dome is full, and must return to Baltimore, who pays for the freight?

A2. The District does not see a problem with taking any salt from any of the two vendors. If it occurred, the District would take the salt.

Q3. Will both vendors receive orders at the same time?

A3. See response number 1.

Q4. What is the purpose of the price for 2500 tons?

A4. This is the minimum the District will order from a vendor during a snow season.
