

73	C.3.2.2	<p>Section C.3.2.2 states, "The Contractor shall connect all cameras to computers or servers which will be housed on the computer rack in the second floor maintenance technician's office."</p> <p>(a) What power (in amps) is available to the office that will hold the DVR?</p> <p>(b) Is there is a wall or fire barrier between the lanes and room where DVR is going? This question refers to a physical wall to stop an actual fire (i.e., not an internet firewall).</p> <p>(c) Is the equipment rack provided by the District, or should vendors the cost of an equipment rack in their bids?</p>	<p>(a). There is a large amount of power supplied to the rack which should be sufficient for a video recorder and any other equipment associated with the video monitoring system (over 100 Amps).</p> <p>(b). Cables can access this room above the ceiling tiles and below the physical roof of the building. It has direct access to the District's intranet which is connected to the internet.</p> <p>(c). The facility already has a computer rack holding some other computer equipment which is in a room on the second floor of the building, separated from the test lanes by two sets of walls.</p>
74	C.3.2.2	<p>Section C.3.2.2 goes on to say, "[The maintenance technician's office] has access to an internet connection of at least broadband quality."</p> <p>(a) Specifically, what type of internet connection (cable, DSL) and what are the upload and download speeds in Mbit/sec?</p> <p>(b) Will a static IP address be assigned to the site? If so, are additional addresses available?</p>	<p>(a). The internet connection will be through a switch built into the rack. The connection through the District's intranet to the internet is 10 megabit up and down.</p> <p>(b). A fixed IP address can be assigned to the video monitoring system.</p>
