

Action 4: Add:

FOR SECTION C:

C.3.28A TROUSERS CLASS "A" FOR MALE AND FEMALE

- C.3.28A.1 STYLE:** Trousers Class "A" Male must be made to be plain front with regular side front pockets with minimum opening of 6 ½". There shall be two hip pockets with a minimum opening of 6".
- C.3.28A.2 FABRIC:** 55% Dacron Polyester 45% wool. The materials must be examined against flaws and imperfections and shall be cold water sponged.
- C.3.28A.3 COLOR:** Police Uniform Blue
- C.3.28A.4 WAISTBAND:** The waistband must be minimum of two inches (2) wide and close with a hook-flex in front. The waistband to be interlined with ban-rol to prevent the waistband from turning. There shall be an insert into the waistband lining of three-strand snugtx or equal. The waistband curtain shall be closed in the back.
- C.3.28A.5 FRONT POCKETS:** Regular side pockets with opening of approximately 6 1/2" and approximately 6" deep from the bottom of the opening. Pocketing to be stitched, turned and top stitched.
- C.3.28A.6 FRENCH FLY:** The trousers must close with Talon #42 metal zipper or equal with a locking slide in machine tape. The zipper stay shall be cut matching Silesia and to exact size as fly and to be surged together. The French Fly shall be made of the same material as the trousers. The fly zipper shall be full ¾" under the opening. The Fly lining shall have a tail covering inseam and crotch. Crotch shall be lined front and back. The Fly shall be bar tacked at the zipper stop.
- C.3.28A.7 INSIDE TRIM:** The right fly and crotch linings must be the same fabric and color as the waistband curtain. The right fly lining shall be sewn to the left fly below the zipper. The inside left and right flies must be fused with an interlining for stability. There must be front and back crotch lining (4 quarters) with a double-folded thickness of twill with no exposed edges. A separate French Fly made of the outer fabric shall be sewn to the inside right fly.
- C.3.28A.8 SEAMS:** Center back runc-under shall be no less than 2 ½" to take care of any alterations and shall be sewn double needle chain stitch machine having tandem needles with an offset of 1/32 of an inch. The inseam is to be sewn with a single needle chain stitch.
- C.3.28A.9 BACK POCKETS:** The back pockets must measure a minimum of 6" wide by 7" deep made on a double piped Reece Pocket machine having an interlined of pellow inside the beazum. The left rear pocket shall have belt loop tab.
- C.3.28A.10 BELT LOOPS:** The belt loops must measure two inches (2) long and: 1 ¼ inches wide of self-fabric, double thickness with the edges butted at the back. A

minimum of seven (7) belt loops. All loops must be sewn in the top and bottom of the waistband with the exception of the back seam that is tacked on.

- C.3.28A.11 BARTACKS:** Triangle bartacks must be sewn at each end of the back pockets and at the bottom of the front pockets. The triangle bartacks will have thirty-two (32) stitches on each side of the triangle, 2 inch long. Eighteen (18) of the stitches must be straight lock stitched and fourteen (14) must be a zigzag covering stitch. All other points of strain must be secured with a straight bartack.
- C.3.28A.12 THREAD:** All thread used will be must be spun polyester.
- C.3.28A.13 FINISHING AND PRESSING:** The trousers must be made in a first class workman like manner with all loose threads removed. Trousers must be pressed completely and properly. Side seams, inseams, and seat seams must be pressed open.
- C.3.28A.14** All trousers bottoms shall be left open to be hemmed at a later date by the Department.
- C.3.46** HAT – Uniform _ Assistant Chief, round top, Navy Commander gold visor synthetic, black velvet band, flat gold chin strap.
- C.3.47** HAT – Uniform _ Battalion Chief, round top, black visor, black velvet band, flat gold chin strap.
- C.3.48** HAT – Uniform _ Deputy Chief, round top, Army gold visor synthetic, black velvet band, flat gold chin strap.
- C.3.49** HAT – Uniform _ Member, round top, black visor, black rope chin strap.
- C.3.50** HAT – Uniform _ Officer, round top, black visor, black mohair braid rope chin strap.

Action 5:

Delete: Section G.10.e its entirety

Insert: Section G.10.e as follows:

Delivery shall be made at destination within fifteen (15) calendars day from date of receipt of purchase order. If the Contractor shall perform alterations to adjust the length of trouser to ensure a proper fit and apply all emblems on the uniform shirts. The Contractor shall deliver uniforms within ten days from measuring.
