1. Delete Section B.3.1.2 in its entirety and replace with the following: B.3.1.2R The per-diem payment equates to the actual number of children/youths served, multiplied by the number of actual days of service.							
2. Delete section B.3.3.1 in its entirety and replace with the following: B.3.3.1R The Provider will be paid on a cost reimbursable basis for the cost of negotiated budgeted items and/or services such as food, shelter, clothing, personal incidentals, school supplies, personal allowance, and travel for the children/youth in care and other charges as identified in the approved Contract Operating Budget, which are not included in either the daily per-diem (direct services) or the monthly administrative rate.							
3. Delete section C.3.8 in its entirety and replace with the following: C.3.8R Community-Based Services – An array of services being delivered to the young adults and/or the family by helping professionals located directly within their community.							
4. Section C.3.23 is deleted in its entirety.							
5. Delete Section H.12.2.4 in its entirety and replace with the following: H.12.2.4R The Contractor shall submit a current organizational chart that displays organizational relationships and demonstrates the staff member with responsibility for administrative oversight and supervision for each activity required under this contract, staff with training authority, staff with programmatic and clinical responsibility, and all other key staff.							
6. Delete section H.12.3.10 in its entirety and replace with the following: H.12.3.10R The Contractor's youth aftercare staff shall collectively have experience and skill in adolescent development, behavior management, child abuse and neglect, family dynamics, psychotropic medication and medication management, and identification and treatment of alcohol and substance abuse.
