

1. As per your request I am writing to you to request the Heights and types of all the towers that are in the solicitation. Some of the types are there but not all of them or the heights of each one.

**Answer:**

*The radio tower located at 4D, 6001 Georgia Ave, NW is a Landmark 700-foot self-supported radio tower.*

*The radio tower located at 2700 Martin Luther King Jr. Ave, SE is a 248-foot Rohn SSVMW self-supported radio tower.*

*The radio tower located at 320 McMillan Drive, NW is a 185-foot Rohn Model 80 self-supported radio tower.*

*The radio tower located at 1700 Rhode Island Ave, NE is a 200-foot Rohn tapered monopole radio tower.*

2. Is there an inventory of the radio and antenna equipment to be  
 maintained, including the manufacturer, model, serial # and status of  
 manufacturer hardware / software warranty? Is this equipment a part of the  
 maintenance agreement or is the maintenance agreement only for the cables,  
 antennas and tower inspection?

**Answer:**

*The SOW as specified in the RFP is for the maintenance and troubleshooting of antenna systems, tower and grounding systems for each of the District radio communications sites, including the four towers above, as well as all building top radio sites. There are no radios associated with this proposal for antenna and tower maintenance. Please refer to Sections B and C of the RFP.*

3. How many cables are at each site location to be included in the sweep?

**Answer:**

*There are four transmit antennas and one receive antenna for each of the UHF and 800 MHz Land Mobile Radio (LMR) systems for a total of 10 LMR antenna systems (please see Section B.4.1, CLIN 0001C) at each of the 10 LMR radio sites. There are three VHF antenna systems at the PSCC radio tower site.*

*There are six microwave radio sites, four of which are co-located with LMR sites. The PSCC has 3 microwave antenna systems, 4D/Hughes has two microwave antenna systems, the Marriott Hotel has two microwave antenna systems, while Fletcher Johnson, St Elizabeth's and GWU sites each have one microwave antenna system.*

4. When are the answers to the questions going to be published?
